- No material from businesses, schools, institutions or churches will be accepted.
- No material from residents living outside of Delaware, Knox, Marion and Morrow counties will be accepted.
- No empty containers will be accepted. If a container is empty it can be placed with your regular garbage.
- No containers of hazardous materials larger than 5-gallons will be accepted.

Acceptable Materials
