Residential Tire Collection Grant

* Please read thoroughly. The application process has changed. *

PROGRAM INTRODUCTION

DKMM will assist municipalities with the logistics and cost of holding a tire collection event for their residents. DKMM will coordinate the delivery of a 40 yard open top container for the collection of passenger and light duty tires from residents. After the event DKMM will ensure the collected tires are delivered to a recycling facility.

DKMM will pay the transportation fee of one container and 20% of the tire recycling fees. The applicant will be invoiced for the remaining balance. It will be up to the applicant to advertise the collection event to their residents, staff the event and collect any fee as set by the applicant.

WHO CAN APPLY

Any township, village or city within Delaware, Knox, Marion, and Morrow counties

MATCH FUNDS

Applicants will be required to demonstrate a financial contribution to the collection according to the following table. We encourage, but do not require, you to collect a fee per tire to help cover the cost of the program. The hope is the event will be low cost or no cost to the applicant. We estimate \$2.50-\$3.00 per tire will cover the recycling fee of passenger and light truck tires. This is an estimate and cannot be guaranteed. If you choose to accept tires on rims, an additional \$6.55 per rim will apply (this is not calculated in the \$2.50-\$3.00 per tire estimate).

Fees are based on contracts DKMM has secured with vendors at a discounted rate.

Applicant is responsible for 100% of all costs associated with additional bins.

ALLOWABLE COSTS

- Tire transportation fee for one 40-yard open top container
- Tire recycling fee for passenger and light truck tires in one container
- Tire rim removal fee for passenger and light truck tires in one container

UNALLOWABLE COSTS

- Any costs associated with more than one 40-yard open top container
- · Advertising and marketing materials
- Staff time
- Equipment costs

FUNDING CRITERIA

Please note, funding is limited. DKMM will consider the following elements in the process of determining grant awards:

- Demonstration of need. Provide a clear description of the issues you are experiencing with tire dumping, tire hording, township/health department involvement in tire enforcement, etc.
- Past participation. Priority will be given to first-time applicants.
- Collection of a fee per tire.
- Applications servicing more than once municipal jurisdiction.
- Potential for evolution into a permanent service without future DKMM funding.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be received by the DKMM office by January 19, 2024

Applications must be submitted no later than the designated date. DKMM offices will be moving in December. **Emailed applications are preferred**. If you are unable to email your application, please contact DKMM for further instructions.

IF YOU RECEIVE FUNDING

The grant document and submitted application will serve as the funding agreement once approved by DKMM. DKMM will pay for all costs associated with one 40-yard container. This consists of a transportation invoice from Mid-Ohio Sanitation and a recycling invoice from Liberty Tire. DKMM will invoice the applicant according to the provided table within 45 days of the event. Reimbursement will be expected within 30 days from the date of receipt of the invoice.

Costs associated with any additional bins over one will be billed directly to the applicant by Mid-Ohio Sanitation and Recycling. There will be one invoice which will include transportation and recycling fees and will be payable to Mid-Ohio Sanitation and Recycling directly. These fees will be billed at the gate rate and may be higher than the costs of the initial container.

EVENT PLANNING

The tire bin(s) will be delivered the day prior to your scheduled event and will be picked up the next business day. For Saturday events, the bin(s) will be delivered Friday and picked up the following Monday.

- Residential tires only, no businesses may bring tires.
- Passenger and light truck tires only, no agriculture or off-road tires or equipment tracks.
 If they are unknowingly placed in the bin, you will be charged 100% of the cost.
- Applicant will be responsible for any and all tires, even if dumped outside the designated collection event.
- Approximately 300 passenger tires will fit in one 40 yd container.
- You can walk into the 40 yd container and will not need to throw tires over the side.
- Limit of 10 tires per trip as outlined by Ohio EPA tire transportation guidelines.
- Applicant must staff the event and neatly stack tires in the provided container.
